### **Business Challenge:**

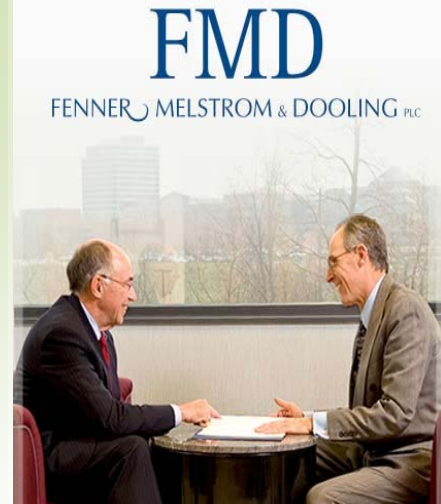
